Subject:- Submission of application/scheme to establish a new Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha/Sowa Rigpa Colleges/increase in intake capacity in existing UG and PG courses and to open new PG courses for the academic session 2026-2027 – reg.

## Sir/Madam

It is submitted that as per the Section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 it is stated that (1) No person shall establish a new medical institution or start any postgraduate course or increase number of seats without obtaining prior permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. (2) For the purpose of obtaining permission under sub-section (1), a person may submit a scheme to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine in such form, containing such particulars, accompanied by such fee, and in such manner, as may be specified by regulations.

Accordingly, the matter was placed in the **119<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM held on **27.02.2025** and Board discussed the same and decided to fix the time period for submitting the new scheme/application to establish New Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha and Sowa Rigpa Colleges, for increase the intake capacity in existing UG & PG courses and to open new PG courses under Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from **1<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025** for the Academic year 2026-2027.

Hence, any Person/Trust/Institution willing to submit an application/scheme for the academic session 2026-27 may submit their application/scheme till 31st July, 2025 through speed post, addressed to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine New Delhi in prescribed format along with all the requisite documents as per the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda/Siddha colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani/Sowa-Rigpa Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2023 and NCISM (Minimum pessential standards, assessment rating and for Postgraduate Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024 and same has also to be uploaded in the given URL which is available in the website of NCISM.

Applicant fulfilling the pre-requisite and eligibility criteria shall submit the application/scheme both online and offline along with all necessary attachments as provided in these Regulation.

Further, all necessary documents to be accompanied by depositing the below mentioned **nonrefundable application and processing fee** by way of a demand draft or online payment payable to "The National Commission Fund for Indian System of Medicine" as per the enforced regulation and detail of same is as under-

All fees are to be added with 18% GST.

Note:-

- 1. Any application/scheme received after the stipulated time period will not be entertained in any case.
- 2. Application shall not be withdrawn after the last date.
- 3. In case of withdrawal of application before the last date, the processing fee shall be refunded.
- 4. Any document of regional language shall be submitted with the translated version of Hindi or English duly attested by the competent authority.
- 5. NOC/COA issued after the last date of submission of application shall not be considered for the Academic year 2026-27 and shall be considered for the academic session 2027-28.
- 6. Application/Scheme shall be scrutinized on the basis of eligibility criteria like Application Fee, No Objection Certificate of the State Government and Consent of Affiliation of the University etc. and only eligible applications fulfilling all the criteria will be accepted for further consideration and the ineligible and incomplete applications shall not be accepted and shall be rejected and returned to the Person/Trust/Institution.
- 7. The application shall be processed as per the Regulations in force as on date.
